Online exams and new qualifiers

- IFoA was the first actuarial body worldwide that offered on-line exams in April 2020 –
 around 7,000 candidates sat for examinations with approx. 10,000 assessments (when a
 restricted portfolio of examinations was offered)
- High exam registrations for the September 2020 session 11,500 candidates sat and 23,000 assessments
